The need of a multidisciplinary team to assist patients with breast cancer is **unquestionable** 



# Interventions of each profession Psychosocials

80.6% of the studies about this topic showed a statistically significant association between at least one psychosocial variable and the outcome of the disease.

#### **Interventions of each profession**

#### **Physiotherapeutic**

- Prevention and treatment of pain, postural and sensitivity changes
- Prevention and treatment of limitation of movements and loss of muscle strength
- Prevention and treatment of respiratory complications and circulatory disorders (lymphoedema).



#### **Interventions of each profession**

#### Nutrional

- Preoperative evaluation of the nutritional risk
- Guide and adjust nutrient input to improve surgical stress response and metabolism
- Post operatory phase: minimize the changes of nutritional status, meet the nutritional needs of the moment and prepare the patient for better metabolic response to the CT to be started



### Interventions of each profession Nursing care

- Guide prevention methods and explanation of the disease and its treatment.
- Nursing care and guidance during all phases of the treatment: surgery, chemotherapy, radiotherapy and hormone therapy.
