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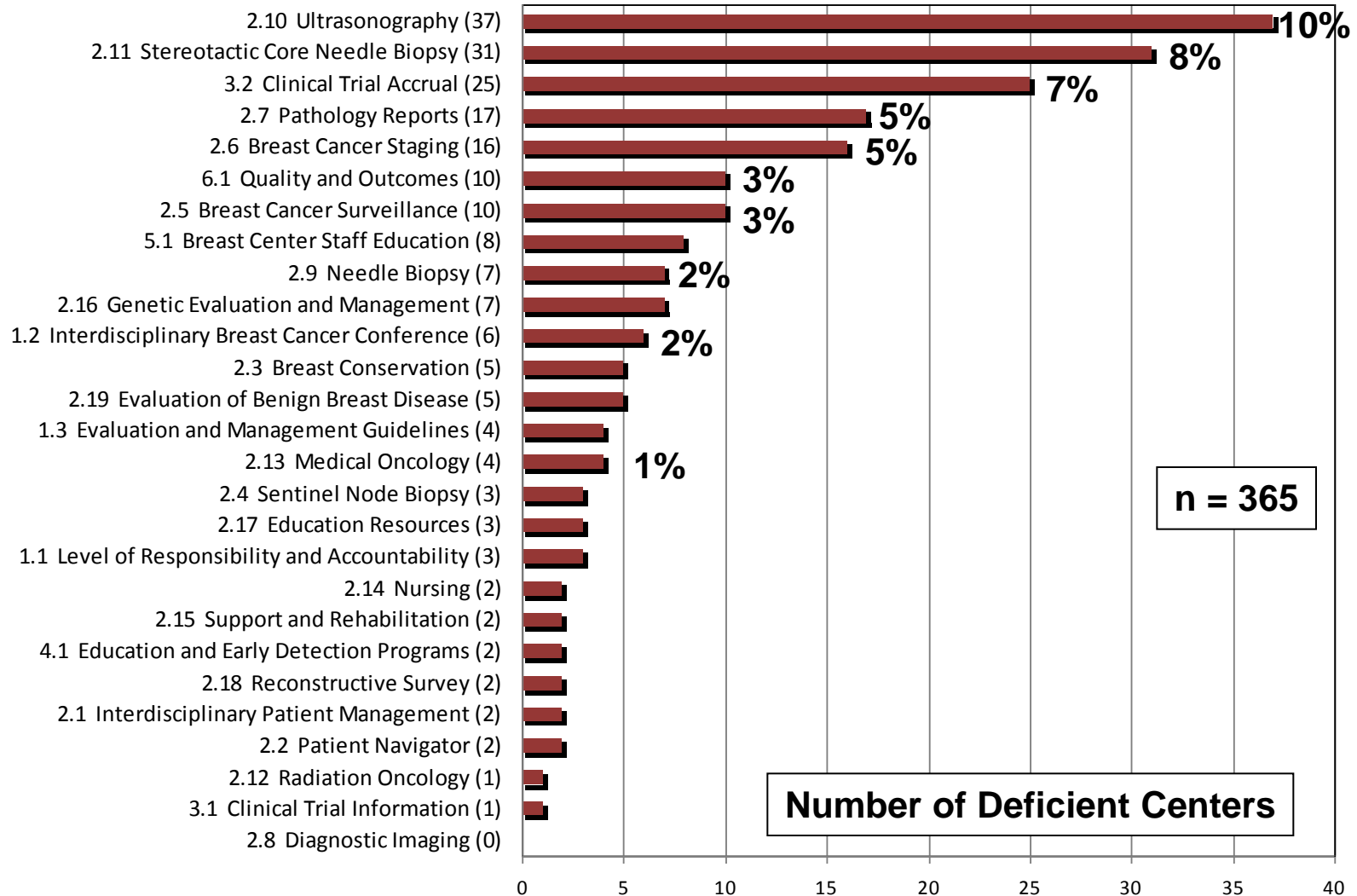
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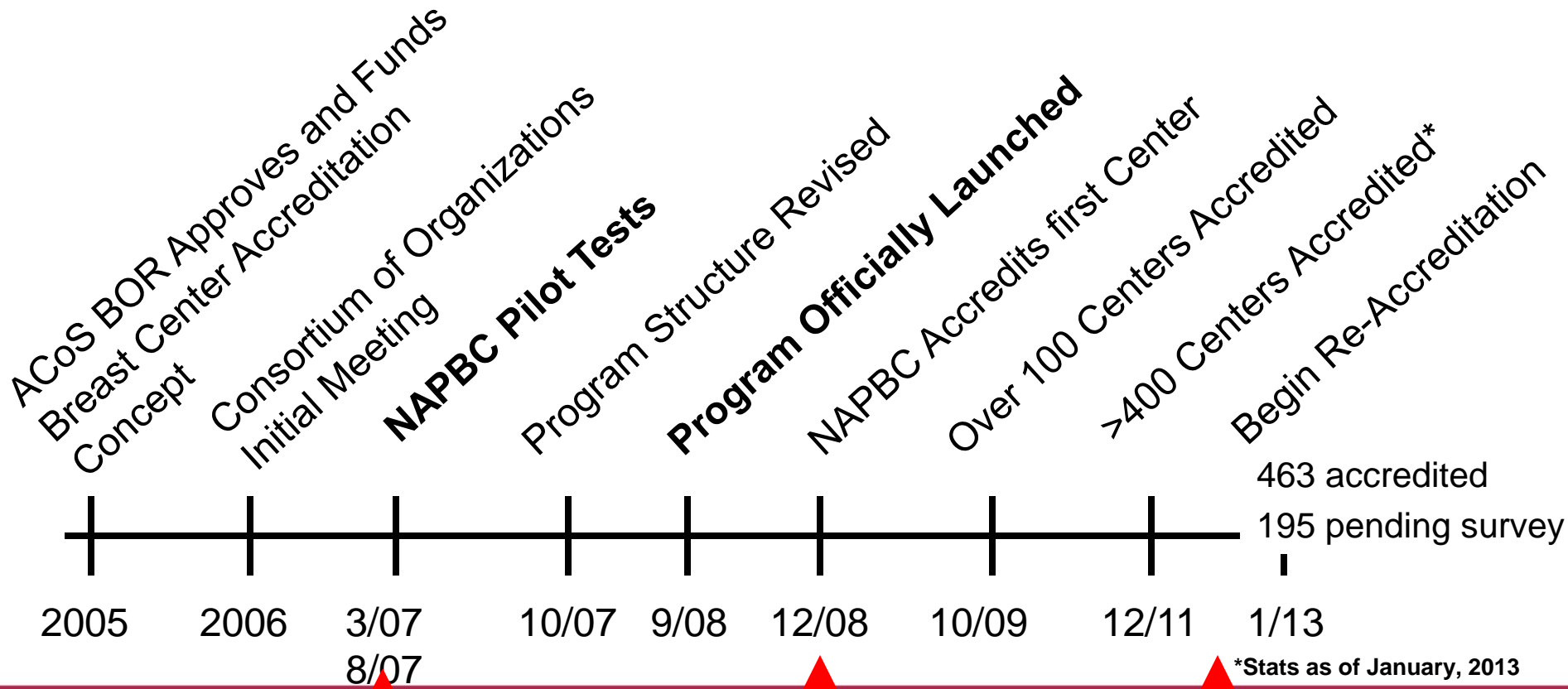

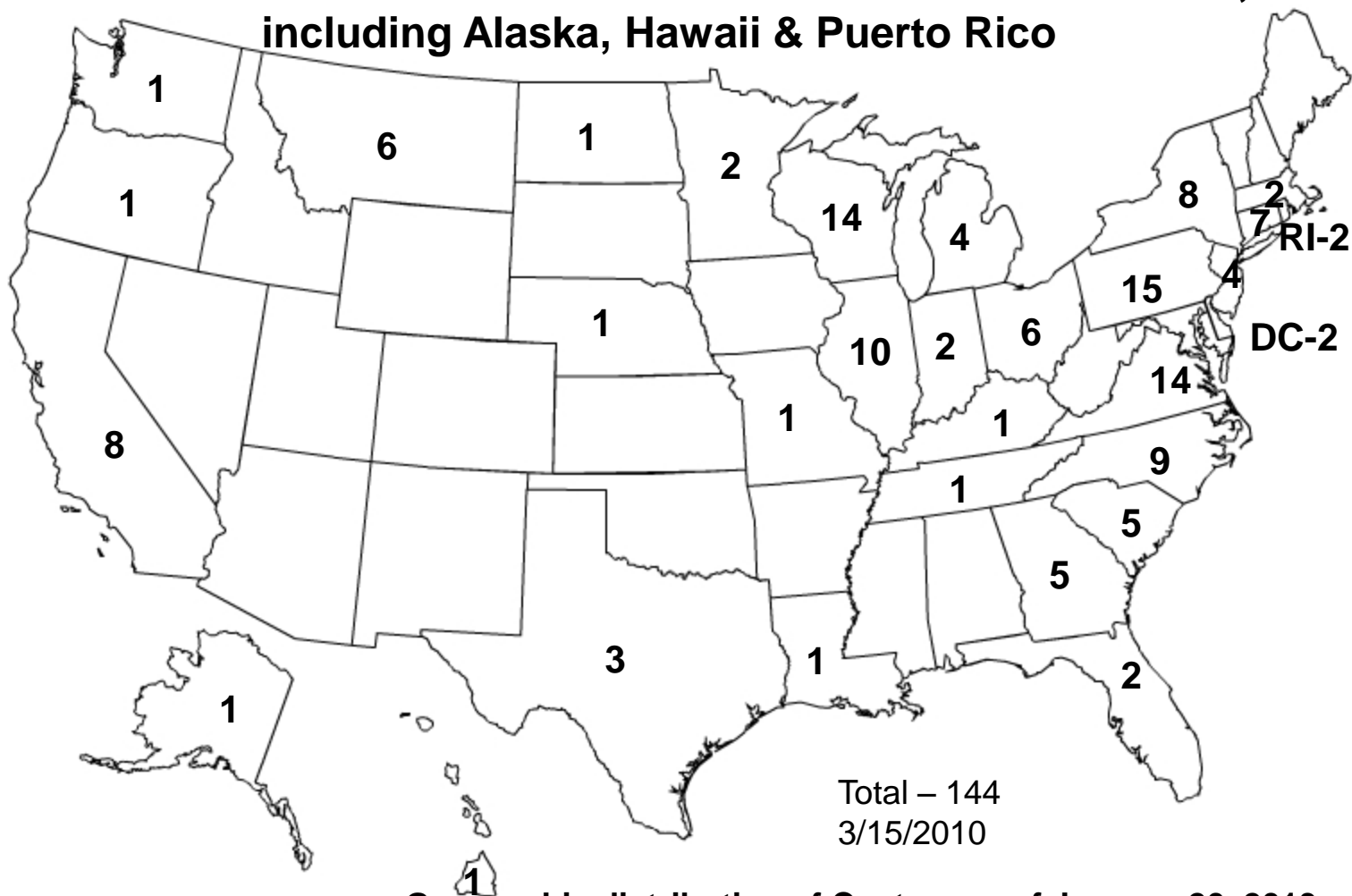


NAPBC Development Timeline

144 NAPBC Accredited Centers can be found in 31 States, including Alaska, Hawaii & Puerto Rico

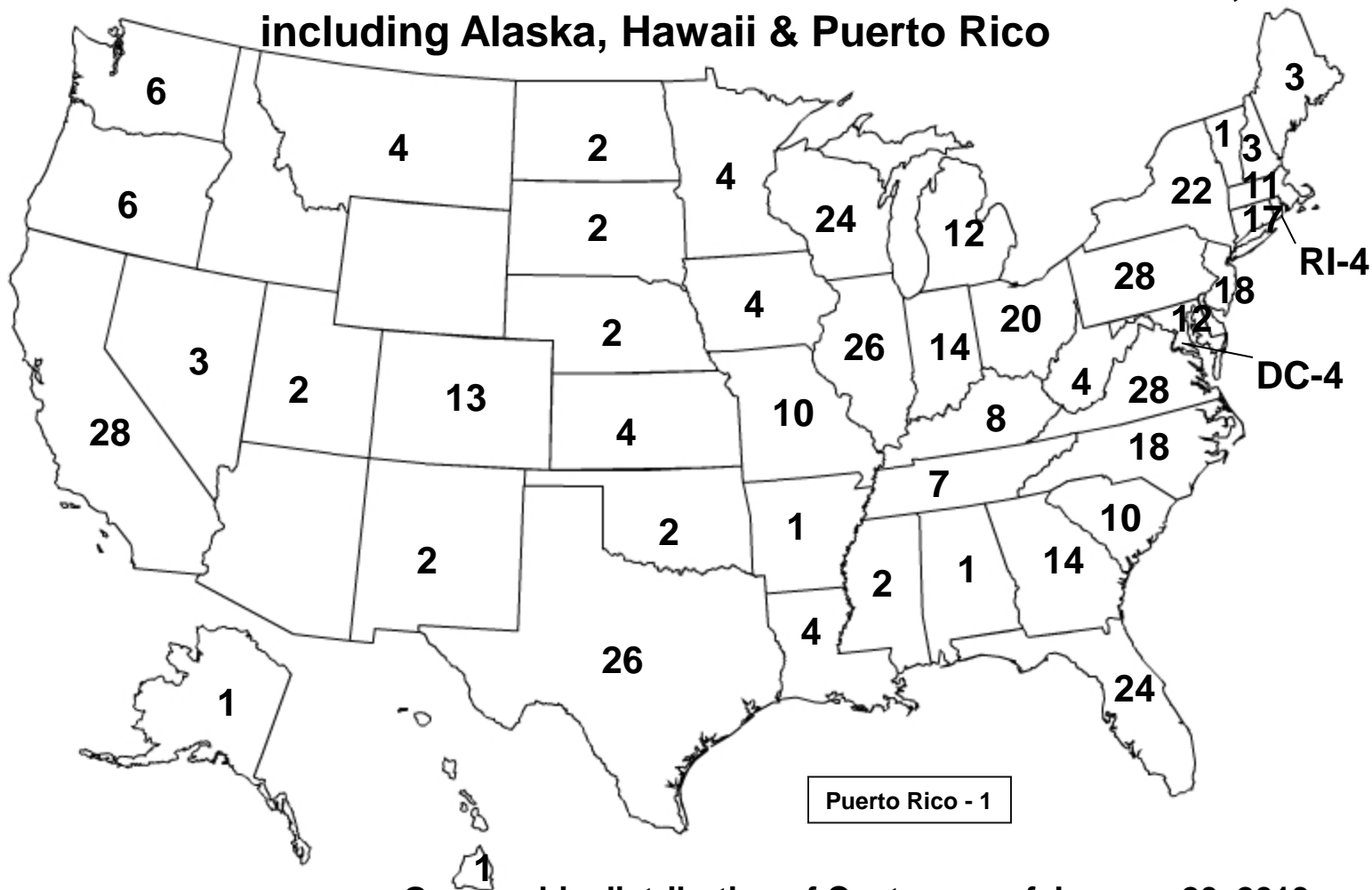


Geographic distribution of Centers as of January 20, 2013



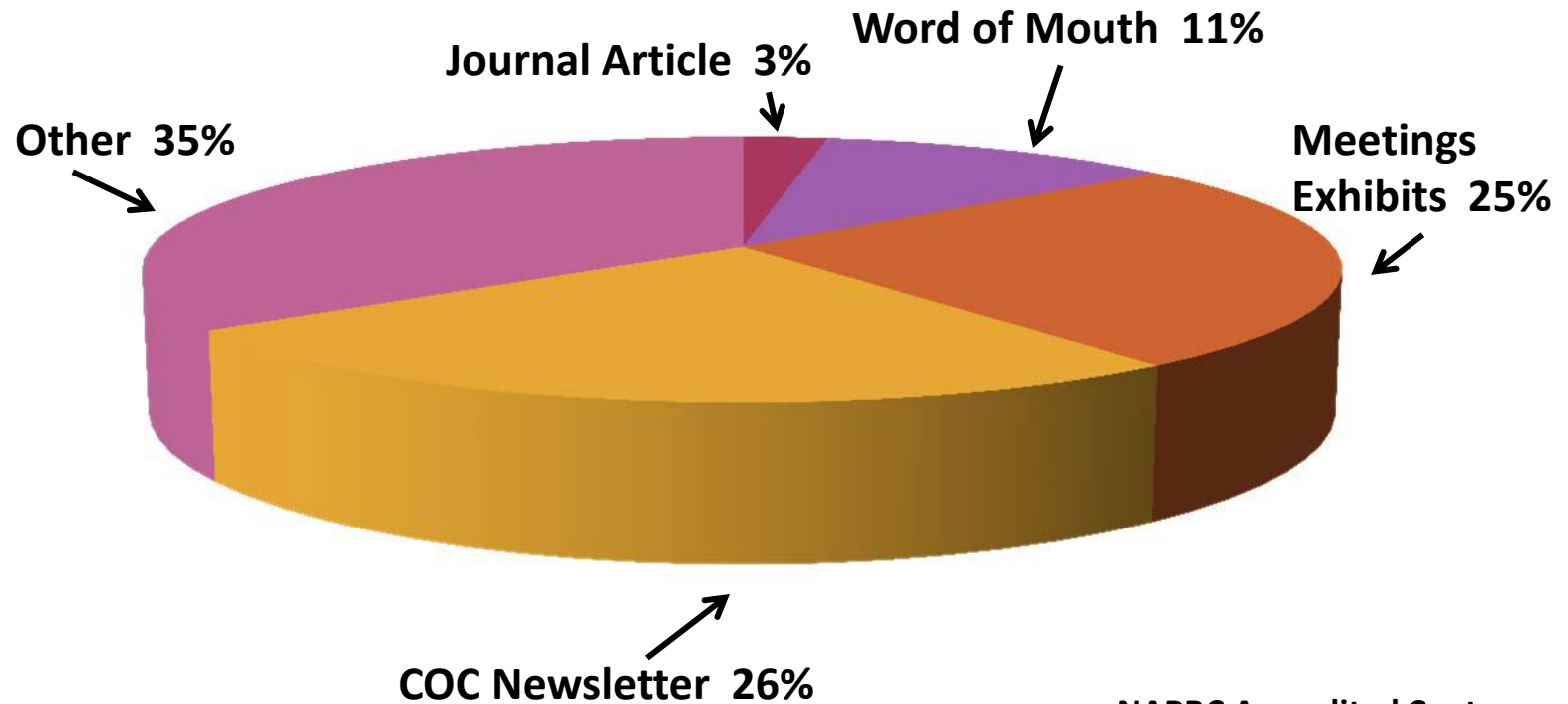

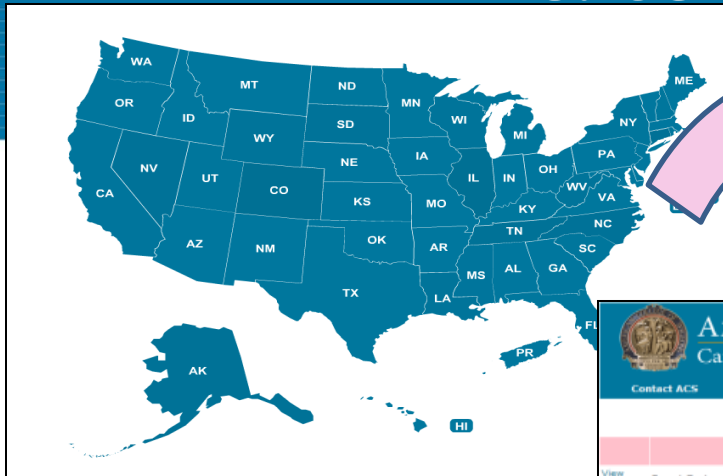

International Committee

Three initiatives were approved by the NAPBC Board:

- 1) Develop a pilot structure for NAPBC international accreditation and adapt standards as needed.
- 2) Collaborate with international societies to investigate an international accreditation for breast centers, (NAPBC, SIS, UICC, EUSOMA), currently called the Breast Center Global Alliance.
- 3) Leverage information from the Breast Health Global Initiative (BHGI) to apply NAPBC Standards to economically-challenged countries.
