Purpose and Value of the Program

The purpose of this program is to define the universal principles applicable to quality breast centers and to describe a method to confirm adherence to these principles of quality breast care. In so doing, we hope to ensure widespread improvement of care for those afflicted with disorders of the breast, both benign and malignant. We wish to ensure the interdisciplinary care of patients with diseases of the breast and to enhance breast care based on recognized international standards. This form of interdisciplinary breast care should be accessible to all women of the world regardless of geographic location.
